

Child health check-up

We promote wellness for its members and encourages Providers' involvement in managing members' physical and mental health needs.

Child Health Check-Ups (CHCUP) (also known as EPSDT) are an integral part of our wellness program. These visits include comprehensive health and developmental history (including assessment of past medical history, developmental history and behavioral health status) for eligible children birth through 20 years old.

As part of our commitment to ensuring members' wellness, Magellan Complete Care will reach out to the parents of newly enrolled child and adolescent members, as well as members with gaps in care, to assist with setting up an appointment with the child's primary care physician for a CHCUP visit, if they have not already done so.

Magellan Complete Care is also reaching out to you, the primary care physician, to ask for your help to please contact your members to get their CHCUP visits scheduled and completed. As part of their benefits, Magellan Complete Care members receive transportation to and from visits through Veyo which can aid in members attending the CHCUP visit.
