HbA1c control	Most recent HbA1c is <8.0	<input type="checkbox"/> 3044F (<7.0)
HbA1c poor control	Most recent HbA1c is >9.0	<input type="checkbox"/> 3046F (>9.0)
Blood pressure control	Most recent blood pressure during the measurement year is <140/90 mm Hg	One systolic code plus one diastolic code: <input type="checkbox"/> 3074F (systolic <130) <input type="checkbox"/> 3075F (systolic 130-139) <input type="checkbox"/> 3078F (diastolic <80) <input type="checkbox"/> 3079F (diastolic 80-89)
