

## Description of the measure

The percentage of members who had the following number of well-child visits with a PCP during the last 15 months. The following rates are reported:

- **Well-child visits in the first 15 months –**  
Children who turned 15 months old during the measurement year: Six or more well-child visits.
- **Well-child visits for ages 15 to 30 months –**  
Children who turned 30 months old during the measurement year: Two or more well-child visits.

## Tips for best practice

- Aim for six or more well-child visits before a child turns 15 months to monitor physical, behavioral and emotional development
- Aim for at least two visits for ages 15 to 30 months
- Check immunization records at every visit and administer vaccines that are due
- Telehealth visits are acceptable to meet the measure requirements
- Emphasize the importance of returning for scheduled well-child visits even if the child is doing fine
