Changes to prior authorization requirements

January 8, 2021

Magellan Complete Care of Florida (MCC of FL) continues to refine prior authorization (PA) requirements in an effort to help our members live healthier lives and to help providers deliver health services more efficiently. This is done by adding and removing PA requirements for certain medications and services.

The chart below shows changes with an effective date of February 8, 2021:
