### American Red Cross

The Red Cross has a free app to help residents in the path of or already impacted by the storm. It includes information such as:

- Hurricane updates.
- What to do before, during and after a disaster.
- A list of open shelters near you.
- An “I’m safe” button that broadcasts to family and friends via social media.
- First aid for 20 common emergencies.
- Pet first aid information with 25 of the most common pet emergencies, and a guide to find the nearest emergency vet and pet-friendly hotels.
